

COMMUNITY

Everyone within Boulder Valley commits to community. We are a relational church and transformation happens best in circles, when rubbing shoulders in authentic relationships. It is easy to spectate at church, but within Boulder Valley, faith is a team sport, and no one is on the bench. But we long even more that they would use the methods of Boulder Valley as tools to create community in their own circles of influence.

CHOOSE TO CONTRIBUTE

Everyone within Boulder Valley chooses to contribute. We define the process of discipleship as "Becoming more like Jesus." This is a journey that never ends but continues to grow in passion and purpose as we learn the Father's heart. And because we are made in the image and likeness of our Creator, we are meant to create. Our society teaches that we are defined by what we consume. But within Boulder Valley, we make contribution, not consumption, our priority. We hope to inspire you to make this a staple of your character because we are a family on mission. We want everyone within Boulder Valley to choose to contribute in one of two places: inside or outside the structures of the church. Choosing to contribute to the mission of God is a primary way we become more like Jesus.

CONNECT TO

ENJOY

We make having an authentic faith with Jesus a priority over being a "Christian" who just does the right things.

HEALTHY

As leaders, we strive for health in all that we do. We prioritize genuine health over healthy appearances. We collaborate and refuse to gossip. We make it our goal to not point out problems unless we also have solutions. Some believe healthy things grow; we believe healthy things produce fruit.

ALL-IN

As leaders, our hearts are invested in the mission of Boulder Valley. We're invested and own our roles. We know that God is excellent and so our excellence matters. Therefore, we strive to honor the Lord with our hard work. We also know that if everyone doesn't weigh in, they won't buy in. It is impossible to run with everyone's ideas, but we want to create an environment where all ideas are heard.

Our Biblical mandate is to make followers of Jesus, also known as disciples. The disciples within Boulder Valley specialize in relationships. It is this lens by which we filter all our programs. - Every follower of Jesus will gather with community on a regular basis (*Acts 2:42-47*)
- Boulder Valley primarily uses Sunday Mornings and Life Groups to help others gather

GROW

- Every follower of Jesus will grow in their emotional and spiritual health (*Luke 10:27*)
- Boulder Valley primarily uses Ultimate Journey and various Trips/Retreats to help others grow

GO

- Every follower of Jesus will go into their circle of influence with a message (*Matthew 28:19-20*)
- Boulder Valley primarily uses Leadership Opportunities and Outreach Partners to help others go
